



STUDENTS WITH TRAVEL MIDAZOLAM FOR TRANSPORT

Dear Parents and Carers,

Students who suffer from Epilepsy / Seizures may require the emergency medication Midazolam. This medication is prescribed by your child's Paediatrician or Specialist Doctors.

If your child requires Midazolam for their seizures and they are transported to William Rose School via Assisted School Travel Program (ASTP) the policies & procedures for travel/medication has changed this year.

Student will be required to have as follows:

Medbag as pictured (available to purchase from William Rose School at **\$10 each**)



In this MedBag will be supplied by you:

Prescribed Midazolam by your doctor/specialist
Syringe (if required with buccals)
Seizure Management Plan signed by doctor/specialist
Administration Order Emergency Medication for Seizures
(signed by doctor/specialist)

This Medbag is to be placed in student's bag for travel to school. It will be taken out of student's bag on arrival at school. It will then be placed back into student's bag on leaving school on transport.
